\$809.150. Life Membership
Fund.

The original amounts paid for life memberships shall be forever kept and maintained as and for a separate and permanent Life Membership Fund. A Lodge may invest its Life Membership Fund as provided in Section 809.130 of this Code, if such investments are kept separate and apart from all other Lodge assets. Only interest or dividends paid in cash on the Life Membership Fund shall be available for general Lodge use.

Next month we will publish updated amounts for those who might be considering life membership in our lodge, but these numbers will give you an idea what a good deal a life membership is.

Under age 49, 21 times annual dues; or \$1,764
50 to 54 inclusive, 19 times annual dues; or \$1,596
55 to 59 inclusive, 17 times annual dues; or \$1,428
60 to 64 inclusive, 14 times annual dues; or \$1,176
65 and over, 11 times annual dues or \$924
