

announce that Brother Chris Clark will be joining in our degrees to provide a musical atmosphere. He is a member of Consuelo Lodge No. 325, in Escondido. He is the brother who played the piano at Bro. Tom Achenbach's' 3rd. We are really looking forward to his talents adding to our degrees.

At our April Stated meeting Wor. Allen discussed purchasing a carpet for our lodge degrees. He found a manufacturer in England that makes custom carpets for Masonic Lodges. We have been in touch with them and have worked up a design, see image in this issue. This is a preliminary design to give you an idea of the overall design. I will have the completed art work by our Stated Meeting and will have it projected on the wall for all to see while we discuss the

purchase particulars. We are talking about paying for the carpet with a combinations of funds from member donations as well as from our general fund. The carpet size will be 12x15 which fits perfectly between the alter and the East steps and the SD and MAR chairs. I was a visitor to SWH the last time purchasing a carpet came up and the brothers I brought up from Temecula were so impressed with SWH's decorum that we affiliated.

Another new addition to the degree experience we will be offering to our candidates is, we will be projecting the lecture slides, available from Grand Lodge, during the 1st and 3rd degree lectures. These are copies of the old school glass slides, that have been digitized for modern projectors. We will also projecting the Trestle Boards from each degree, since we'll already be setup.

Masonic Education

I gave the April lecture on the Mason's path thru the Tarot. It follows the Mason thru the Higher Arcana. I gave a masonic perspective to the meaning of the cards and the gifts the image offers to the Mason. We had a pretty good turn out and several brothers asked for a cope of the power point.

Our May 21st Lecture will be presented by Brother Alan Gatlin. I don't have the information on his paper yet, but his are all really well done. Although I will be on vacation, I am going to do my best to get down to SD to attend. You probably should too.

I will be giving the June 18 lecture on the hypnosis that naturally takes place in our ritual. I explain what hypnosis is, and how it works.
