MASONIC TRIVIA

On the Revolutionary Battlefield at Saratoga, there is a curious monument. It depicts a single boot, draped over an upturned cannon barrel, with the inscription:

In memory of the most brilliant soldier of the Continental Army who was desperately wounded on this spot the sally port of BORGOYNES GREAT WESTERN REDOUBT 7th October; 1777 winning for his countrymen the decisive battle of the American Revolution and for himself the rank of Major General.

The monument does not bear the name of the person for whom it was erected. Who was this man?

In July of 1779, the 17th Regiment of His Majesty's Army was captured at Stony Point and its Masonic dispensation warrant and regalia fell into the hands of American troops. The U. S. commander, Genl. Samuel H. Parsons instantly recognized what his troops had recovered, and he immediately returned the items, with the following note: "When the ambitions of Monarchs or jarring interests of contending States call forth their subjects to war, as Masons we are disarmed of that resentment which stimulates to undistinguished desolation; and however our political sentiments may impel us in the public dispute, we are still brethren, and (our professional duty apart) ought to promote the happiness and advance the weal of each other. Accept therefore, at the hands of a brother, the Constitution of (your lodge)... which your late misfortunes have put in my power to restore to you"
