WE'D LOVE TO HAVE YOU BACK!

To those good Brothers who were suspended for non-payment of dues at the September Stated Meeting. Your lack of payment may have been a terrible oversight and it can be corrected as stated below. The suspensions were necessary since each year that you did not pay, the Lodge had to pay the per-capita to the Grand Lodge in your stead. Over the past two to three years, this amount has exceeded \$3,000 of lodge money. The suspensions put an end to this requirement.

As you were told in the letter, this suspension will also cause your suspension in any other Masonic Organizations in which you may have membership, such as the Scottish Rite, Shrine, York Rite etc.

If you should decide that you would again like to be a Mason in Good Standing in the greatest fraternity in the world, your membership can be <u>automatically</u> restored by paying to the Lodge the dues now owing <u>plus the current year dues at that time</u>. However, for <u>automatic restoration</u> (without approval by the Lodge needed) your payment must be made <u>within two years</u> from the date of suspension September 5, 2017.

If you should wish to restore your membership after September 5, 2019, any such application must be made in this Lodge and will require an investigation and vote of approval by the members at a Stated Meeting, together with your check for dues now owing and for current dues at that time.

Also, please understand that once you have been restored to good standing by paying your back dues, you must continue to support your lodge by staying current by paying your annual dues by January first of each year. Not maintaining your good standing could once again be cause for suspension for non-payment of dues.
