

PONTERINGS

From Geometry the lost art of Navigation tricks known to a few, for you to try and hone that some day might be useful or impress your grand children or others. The first requires the use of a wristwatch the other a tall stick say thirty inches. The watch method must not use DST in fact just the opposite, in winter it is set ahead one hour and in summer back one hour with spring and fall left alone. Point the hour hand in the direction of the sun determine the midpoint between it and twelve on the dial and that is the direction of south. The

opposite is true in the Southern Hemisphere. Place a stick in the ground as straight as possible and mark it's shadow with a stone, wait say fifteen minutes and place a stone an equal distance from the pole on the shadow and draw a line across determine the midpoint sight to the pole and that direction is south the two stones also indicate east and west. have some fun and try your skill against a compass. Both methods become difficult as you approach noon.
