

Grand Lodge, on Historic California Street at the top of Knob Hill, facing Grace Cathedral a mere six blocks via the Cable Car Line from the Golden Gateway Holiday Inn, was the venue for our Lodge Members visit for the 166<sup>th</sup> annual Communication in Mid-October. This was my second enjoyable visit, and I bring back some communication highlights:

The Resolution to donate \$1.00, per Mason, to the George Washington Masonic National Memorial has passed. There were many reasons presented to pass this motion, with the essence being that the California Lodge was instrumental in funding the initial construction, it is a Fraternal Treasure, and we should continue to support its needs.

The matter of acknowledging other Man's Sacred Writings, if not the Holy Bible, on the Alter during initiation, is a carryover as it requires some further clarifications. The related Resolution to remove the closed Bible from the Alter in these cases failed to pass, with the most compelling reasoning being that Biblical Scripture is interwoven throughout our ritual, and consequently the presence of the Bible is always going to be a necessity.

All Line Officers can relax a little, since the Resolution to require qualification before elections, is carried over. In a similar resolution, the allowance for Two Proficient Masons to divide the First and Third Degree Lectures into portions has been carried over. There is a purist opinion heard, that contends the Long Forms need to be performed only by One Person to preserve their beauty.

The Judicial portion of the meeting aired out interpersonal grievances' that existed between Brothers, and I can say that I am gladly a member of a Lodge that doesn't fight in the parking lot.

Looking forward now, we have scheduled a First Degree on November 10<sup>th</sup>. December will be move up month, and the Installation of Officers for the Ensuing Masonic Year is set for Saturday December 12<sup>th</sup>, at High Twelve.

#### Schools of Esoteric Mysticism


## EDITOR'S NOTE
